Long Island's "Green-Tech Corridor" Chosen for U.S. Headquarters

Toronto, Ontario and Melville, New York – June 3, 2009 – Oneworld Energy Inc., an emerging leader in the design, installation, management and servicing of both wind and solar power installations, today announced plans to expand its U.S. presence, including the appointment of Roger M.
